

Articles, Packages, and Carts on Vehicles

## **Purpose**

To ensure safety of passengers and to provide guidance to drivers on handling articles and packages.

## **GUIDELINES**

- 1) Passengers have a carry-on limit of four items, such a paper or plastic bags containing groceries. Items must be small enough to be controlled by the passenger within the space occupied by the passenger. No big boxes, bulky items, or large bags that would be considered a "household move" are permitted.
- 2) Items must be under the control of the passenger in such a way that the items will not move about freely and cause a safety hazard. Items may not block aisles or passenger entry doors.
- 3) Only two-wheeled carts are allowed on buses. No four-wheeled carts are permitted on buses. Passengers with two-wheeled carts may use the lift or ramp when boarding the vehicle. If possible, the passenger should fold the cart and stow it where it will not obstruct the aisle.
